4. Matters arising from the minutes

a) Kinwarton House business activities vs planning consent

It was noted that a change of use application has been submitted for The Piggery

b) Marla Tubes security fencing

MC confirmed he continues to chase on KPC's behalf.

Feedback from the Planning Dept shows they understand KPC's concerns and will look in to how the process was handled.

c) Parish Plan Actions

Items below remain on the agenda for monitoring

- Speeding traffic MC on-going project

KR noted that the flashing speed monitor on Arden Road has become hidden in the hedge & suggested it should be placed elsewhere more obvious. MC to investigate.

- Poor repair of footpath running to Coughton Fields Lane – MC/WCH

MC suggested KPC remind Alan Caldwell-Jones of this site repair.

d) Additional waste bin

KR has visited the site and noted an area of grass, between the Spar car park and the housing estate, which may be suitable. It is unclear at this stage who owns this piece of land.

KPC to approach Spar management to ascertain whether they would be willing to pay for purchase & installation of a bin which KPC would maintain/empty.

e) Grass cutting at the Memorial Hall

Correspondence from Martyn Davey to Limebridge was read out. All councillors present agreed that KPC had agreed to pay for x6 cuts per year at the Hall. The clerk to confirm this with Limebridge.

f) Faulty Street light o/s 16 Throckmorton Road

No feedback received from the Street Lighting Dept. MM to enquire with nearby residents whether the repair has been effected.
